Senate Bill 245

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Requires Adjutant General to grant militia member's request for exemption to immunization requirements because of member's religious beliefs.

2	Relating to the Oregon National Guard's immunization requirements.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2023 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 399.
5	SECTION 2. The Adjutant General shall grant a member of the organized militia an ex-
6	emption to an immunization requirement if:
7	(1) The member requests an exemption because of the member's religious beliefs; and
8	(2) The immunization requirement conflicts with the member's religious beliefs.
