SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Judicial Department to study allocation of parental decision-making. Directs department to submit findings to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to judiciary not later than September 15, 2024.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to allocation of parental rights.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> The Judicial Department shall study the allocation of parental decision-

5 making. The department shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and

6 may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative

7 Assembly related to the judiciary no later than September 15, 2024.
