Senate Bill 319

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SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Provides that person who contracts with public body to provide services for purposes of community restoration or to restore fitness to proceed is state officer, employee or agent for purposes of indemnification under Oregon Tort Claims Act under certain circumstances.

A BILL FOR AN ACT 1 Relating to the Oregon Tort Claims Act. 2 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 3 SECTION 1. A person who contracts with a public body to provide services pursuant to 4 ORS 161.365 and 161.370 for the purposes of community restoration or to restore fitness to 5 proceed is a state officer, employee or agent for purposes of ORS 30.285 only with regard to 6 claims alleging injury or death arising from the acts of a criminal defendant receiving services under ORS 161.365 and 161.370. 8 SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2023 Act applies to claims arising on or after the effective 9 date of this 2023 Act. 10 11
