## Senate Bill 403

Sponsored by Senator PATTERSON, Representative EVANS (Presession filed.)

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Allows person who retires from Department of State Police as police officer to participate in group benefit plan offered by Public Employees' Benefit Board with no increase in premiums.

1 A BILL FOR AN ACT

- 2 Relating to the Public Employees' Benefit Board.
- 3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2023 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 243.105 to 243.285.
  - **SECTION 2.** (1) As used in this section:
  - (a) "Normal retirement age" has the meaning given that term in ORS 238.005 or 238A.160, as applicable.
    - (b) "Police officer" has the meaning given that term in ORS 238.005.
  - (2) A person who is a retired member of the Public Employees Retirement System and who retired from the Department of State Police as a police officer on or after reaching normal retirement age shall be eligible to participate as a retired employee in one of the group benefit plans described in ORS 243.135. The premium amounts charged to a retired employee for coverage under this section may not exceed the premium amounts charged to the employee before the employee was retired.
