Relating to memorial highways.

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Provides that portion of Oregon Highway 82 shall be known as Deputy Raymond Williams and Deputy Michael Cheney Memorial Highway.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Whereas on November 5, 1980, Union County Deputies Raymond Williams and Michael Lynn 3 Cheney were killed in the line of duty in their service vehicle while returning from a search and 4 rescue mission; and 5 Whereas Deputies Williams and Cheney were traveling south on Oregon Highway 82 near Elgin, 6 Oregon, when they were hit head-on by a driver who was impaired by intoxication from alcohol; and 7 Whereas Deputy Williams was 33 years old when he died and had been with the Union County 8 Sheriff's Office for five years; and 9 Whereas Deputy Williams was survived by his wife, son and daughter; and 10 11 Whereas Deputy Cheney was 38 years old when he died and was on his 14th day of service with the Union County Sheriff's Office, after previously serving with the Douglas County Sheriff's Office; 12 and 13 Whereas Deputy Cheney was survived by his two daughters, parents and siblings; and 14 15 Whereas designating a portion of Oregon Highway 82 as a memorial highway to Deputies Williams and Cheney will honor their service to benefit the lives of others and the ultimate sacrifice 16 they made in the line of duty, while also paying respect to the families they left behind; and 17 Whereas a memorial highway to Deputies Williams and Cheney acknowledges the thousands of 18 law enforcement officers in the State of Oregon who are currently serving in harm's way to protect 19 20 our safety and peace; and 21 Whereas designating the portion of Oregon Highway 82 between mileposts 18 and 25 as the
