## A-Engrossed Senate Bill 5502

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Department of Administrative Services for certain biennial expenses.

Limits certain biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and certain federal funds, but excluding lottery funds and other federal funds, collected or received by department.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from certain lottery moneys. Limits biennial expenditures by department from federal funds. Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2023.

33 <u>SECTION 3.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 34 \$47,431,606 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for 35 payment of expenses by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services from lottery 36 moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund for debt 37 service and related costs for bonds issued in previous biennia.

38 <u>SECTION 4.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 39 \$3,828,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for 40 payment of expenses to support the county fairs in this state from lottery moneys allocated 41 from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to the Oregon Department 42 of Administrative Services that are deposited in the County Fair Account established under 43 ORS 565.445.

44 <u>SECTION 5.</u> (1) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 45 \$1,944,041 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for

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1 payment of expenses by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services from American

2 Rescue Plan Act Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund moneys received by the Oregon

3 Department of Administrative Services, for the Chief Financial Office.

4 (2) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$15,708,570 is es-5 tablished for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of ex-6 penses by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services from American Rescue Plan 7 Act Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund moneys received by the Oregon Department of 8 Administrative Services, for the office of the State Chief Information Officer.

9 <u>SECTION 6.</u> For the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, the following expenditures by the
 10 Oregon Department of Administrative Services are not limited:

(1) Expenditures from the Insurance Fund for acquiring and purchasing insurance or
 reinsurance, allocating and collecting premiums and paying claims for coverage pursuant to
 statutory authority.

(2) Expenditures from the Mass Transit Assistance Account for payments described in
 ORS 291.407 to mass transit districts, transportation districts and service districts.

16 <u>SECTION 7.</u> This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 17 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect 18 July 1, 2023.

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
