18 "<u>SECTION 3.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 19 \$47,431,606 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for 20 payment of expenses by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services from lottery 21 moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund for debt 22 service and related costs for bonds issued in previous biennia.

²³ "<u>SECTION 4.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of ²⁴ \$3,828,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for ²⁵ payment of expenses to support the county fairs in this state from lottery moneys allocated ²⁶ from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund to the Oregon Department ²⁷ of Administrative Services that are deposited in the County Fair Account established under ²⁸ ORS 565.445.

29 "<u>SECTION 5.</u> (1) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 30 \$1,944,041 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for 31 payment of expenses by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services from American 32 Rescue Plan Act Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund moneys received by the Oregon 33 Department of Administrative Services, for the Chief Financial Office.

34 "(2) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$15,708,570 is 35 established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of 36 expenses by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services from American Rescue Plan 37 Act Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund moneys received by the Oregon Department of 38 Administrative Services, for the office of the State Chief Information Officer.

³⁹ "<u>SECTION 6.</u> For the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, the following expenditures by the

41 "(1) Expenditures from the Insurance Fund for acquiring and purchasing insurance or
