Senate Bill 5510

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Concurrent Resolution 23 (2023) (at the request of Oregon Department of Administrative Services)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to State Department of Geology and Mineral Industries for biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and specified federal funds, but excluding lottery funds and other federal funds, collected or received by department.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from other federal funds. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2023.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the financial administration of the State Department of Geology and Mineral Industries;

3 and declaring an emergency.

4 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

5 <u>SECTION 1.</u> There are appropriated to the State Department of Geology and Mineral 6 Industries, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the following 7 amounts, for the following purposes:

8 (1) Geological survey...... \$ 6,976,262

9 (2) Mined land reclamation \$ 2,834,349

10 <u>SECTION 2.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts 11 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limits for payment 12 of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and fed-13 eral funds for contract services, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described 14 in this section, collected or received by the State Department of Geology and Mineral In-15 dustries, for the following purposes:

16 (1) Geologic survey...... \$ 2,508,573

17 (2) Mined land reclamation \$ 4,384,797

18 <u>SECTION 3.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 19 \$5,519,902 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for 20 payment of expenses from federal funds other than those described in section 2 of this 2023 21 Act, collected or received by the State Department of Geology and Mineral Industries.

22 <u>SECTION 4.</u> This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 23 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect 24 July 1, 2023.
