- "(2) Expenditures from the federal funds Women, Infants and Children Program food voucher redemptions.
- "SECTION 7. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$2,488,161,194 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the Public Employees' Benefit Board from the Public Employees' Revolving Fund for benefit plan premiums and self-insurance.
- "SECTION 8. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of \$1,994,469,796 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the Oregon Educators Benefit Board from the Oregon Educators Revolving Fund for benefit plan premiums and self-insurance.

"SECTION 9. This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect July 1, 2023.".

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
