(1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is ap-29propriated to the Emergency Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the 30 31 General Fund, the amount of \$3,000,000, to be allocated to the Public Defense Services Commission for Adult Trial Division or Juvenile Trial Division caseload costs the commission is 32unable to mitigate during the interim legislative periods. 33 "(2) If any of the moneys appropriated by subsection (1) of this section are not allocated 34 by the Emergency Board prior to December 1, 2024, the moneys remaining on that date be-

come available for any purpose for which the Emergency Board lawfully may allocate funds.
 "<u>SECTION 4.</u> Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation
 made to the Public Defense Services Commission by section 1 (5), chapter 444, Oregon Laws
 2021, for the biennium ending June 30, 2023, for Nonroutine Expenses, is decreased by
 \$413,560.

⁶ <u>SECTION 5.</u> Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund appropriation
⁷ made to the Public Defense Services Commission by section 1 (6), chapter 444, Oregon Laws
⁸ 2021, for the biennium ending June 30, 2023, for Court Mandated Expenses, is decreased by
