SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board for certain biennial expenses.

Directs board to allocate moneys from Watershed Conservation Operating Fund to various state agencies to implement Article XV, section 4b, of Oregon Constitution. Limits biennial expenditures by board from federal funds and lottery moneys.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by board.

Directs board to establish by rule process for allocating available moneys in Natural Resources Subaccount of Parks and Natural Resources Fund.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2023.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon: 4

SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board, for $\mathbf{5}$ the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$1,000,000 for 6

operations. 7

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SECTION 1a. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-8 priated to the Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 9 10 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$15,466,689, for the distribution of grants specified in section 69, chapter 669, Oregon Laws 2021. 11

SECTION 1b. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-12 priated to the Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 13 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$4,240,706, for the distribution of grants de-14 scribed in section 303, chapter 110, Oregon Laws 2022, for natural resource recovery actions 1516 in areas affected by 2021 fires.

17 SECTION 1c. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board, for the biennium beginning July 1, 18 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$3,452,949, for the distribution of grants de-19 20 scribed in sections 19 to 23, chapter 4, Oregon Laws 2021 (second special session).

21SECTION 2. Of the moneys deposited into the Watershed Conservation Operating Fund established under ORS 541.945, the Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board shall allocate 2223\$9,000,385 to the Department of State Police for fish and wildlife activities to implement Ar-

2 <u>SECTION 3.</u> Of the moneys deposited into the Watershed Conservation Operating Fund 3 established under ORS 541.945, the Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board shall allocate 4 \$6,818,367 to the State Department of Fish and Wildlife for activities and projects to imple-5 ment Article XV, section 4b, of the Oregon Constitution.

6 <u>SECTION 4.</u> Of the moneys deposited into the Watershed Conservation Operating Fund 7 established under ORS 541.945, the Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board shall allocate 8 \$8,859,764 to the State Department of Agriculture for activities and projects to implement 9 Article XV, section 4b, of the Oregon Constitution.

10 <u>SECTION 5.</u> Of the moneys deposited into the Watershed Conservation Operating Fund 11 established under ORS 541.945, the Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board shall allocate 12 \$4,908,369 to the Department of Environmental Quality for activities and projects to imple-13 ment Article XV, section 4b, of the Oregon Constitution.

14 <u>SECTION 6.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of 15 \$9,228,766 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for 16 payment of expenses by the Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board from lottery moneys 17 deposited into the Watershed Conservation Operating Fund established under ORS 541.945, 18 for operating expenses, activities and projects to implement Article XV, section 4b, of the 19 Oregon Constitution.

<u>SECTION 7.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board, for the following purposes:

27 <u>SECTION 8.</u> Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts 28 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limits for payment 29 of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Oregon Watershed Enhancement 30 Board, for the following purposes:

31 (1) Operations..... \$ 4,377,048

32 (2) Grants...... \$ 52,659,999

<u>SECTION 9.</u> (1) The Oregon Watershed Enhancement Board shall establish by rule a process for allocating on a quarterly basis available moneys in the Natural Resources Subaccount of the Parks and Natural Resources Fund, established under ORS 541.942, to fulfill the biennial allocations made in this 2023 Act. Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, all quarterly allocations shall be set at one-eighth of the biennial allocations.

(2) If, in any quarter, the moneys transferred from the Oregon State Lottery Fund to the
Parks and Natural Resources Fund are insufficient to pay for the quarterly allocations established under subsection (1) of this section, the allocations shall be reduced proportionately
by amounts sufficient to accommodate the revenue shortfall.

42 <u>SECTION 10.</u> This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public 43 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect 44 July 1, 2023.

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
