

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 5541

By JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 28 and delete page 2 and insert:

2 “**SECTION 1.** There are appropriated to the Oregon Youth Authority, for the biennium  
3 beginning July 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for the following  
4 purposes:

- 5 (1) Facility programs..... \$191,806,318
- 6 (2) Community programs ..... \$ 80,686,520
- 7 (3) Program support..... \$ 63,405,290
- 8 (4) Juvenile crime  
9 prevention/diversion..... \$ 22,502,019
- 10 (5) Multnomah County gang  
11 prevention services ..... \$ 3,808,146
- 12 (6) Debt service ..... \$ 19,999,509
- 13 (7) Capital improvements ..... \$ 1,732,843

14 “**SECTION 2.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts  
15 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limits for payment  
16 of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-  
17 cluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Oregon Youth Authority,  
18 for the following purposes:

- 19 (1) Facility programs..... \$ 5,051,582
- 20 (2) Community programs ..... \$ 2,570,757
- 21 (3) Program support..... \$ 5,542,557

22 “**SECTION 3.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts  
23 are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limits for payment  
24 of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the Oregon Youth Authority, for the  
25 following purposes:

- 26 (1) Community programs ..... \$ 35,983,223
- 27 (2) Program support..... \$ 2,035,953

28 “**SECTION 4.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of  
29 \$4,259,816 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for  
30 payment of expenses by the Oregon Youth Authority from American Rescue Plan Act  
31 Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund moneys received by the Oregon Department of Ad-  
32 ministrative Services and transferred to the Oregon Youth Authority, for capital improve-  
33 ments and the Juvenile Justice Information System upgrade project.

34 “**SECTION 5.** This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public  
35 peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect

1 **July 1, 2023.”**

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
