SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

[Increases amount residential landlord owes tenant for landlord-cause termination of tenancy.]

[Limits annual rent increases.]

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to Housing and Community Services Department to provide residential tenant assistance.

[Declares emergency, effective on passage.]

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to residential tenancies.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropri-**
5 **ated to the Housing and Community Services Department, for the biennium beginning July**
6 **1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$25,000,000, to provide residential tenant as-**
7 **sistance to individuals who are disabled, elderly, victims of domestic abuse, veterans or**
8 **members of households with incomes of 60 percent or less of the area median income.**
