## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 643

On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 32 and delete page 2 and insert: 1 2 "SECTION 1. ORS 616.723 is amended to read: 3 "616.723. (1) As used in this section: "(a) 'Food' and 'food establishment' have the meanings given those terms in ORS 616.695. 4 5 'Food' does not include any article containing cannabis. "(b) 'Potentially hazardous' means requiring temperature control due to the capacity to support 6 7 the rapid and progressive growth of infectious microorganisms or the growth of toxic 8 microorganisms. 9 (c) 'Retailer' means a person who engages in the business of selling consumer goods to 10 retail buyers. 'Retailer' includes coffee shops and excludes restaurants. 11 "(2) ORS 616.695 to 616.755 do not apply to a food establishment if: 12"(a) The food establishment is located in a residential dwelling; 13 "[(b) The food establishment sells food only to the end user of the product;] 14 "[(c)] (b) The foods prepared at the food establishment for public distribution are packaged and 15not potentially hazardous, including but not limited to baked goods, confectionary items, coffee 16 beans, teas, popcorn, jams, jellies, honey, syrups, fruit butters, nut mixes, repackaged 17 freeze-dried foods, repackaged dried and dehydrated foods and powdered drink mixes; 18 "[(d) The foods prepared at the food establishment for public distribution are baked goods or 19 confectionary items;] 20 "[(e)] (c) The food bears on its label a statement and product information as described in sub-21section [(4)] (6) of this section informing consumers that the product is not prepared in an inspected 22food establishment; 23 "[(f) Except as provided in subsection (6) of this section, the annual gross sales of foods prepared 24at the food establishment do not exceed \$20,000; and] 25(d) The annual gross sales of foods prepared at the food establishment do not exceed \$50,000, adjusted annually for inflation pursuant to the Consumer Price Index for All Urban 2627Consumers, West Region (All Items), as published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics of the 28United States Department of Labor and rounded to the nearest \$100; and 29 "[(g)] (e) Each individual involved in the preparation of food at the food establishment for public 30 distribution has successfully completed a food handler training program and holds a certificate is-31 sued under ORS 624.570. 32"[(3) A person may not sell foods prepared in an establishment described in this section on the 33 Internet or to a commercial entity or an institution including, but not limited to, a restaurant, grocery 34 store, caterer, school, day care center, hospital, nursing home or correctional facility.] 35"(3) A person may not sell foods prepared in a food establishment described in subsection

1 (2) of this section to an institution including, but not limited to, a caterer, school, day care 2 center, hospital, nursing home, correctional facility or restaurant.

3 "(4) A person may sell foods prepared in a food establishment described in subsection (2) 4 of this section directly to the end user in any manner, including from the home, online, through the mail and at events. 5

6 (5) A person may sell packaged foods prepared in a food establishment described in 7 subsection (2) of this section to a retailer if the retailer agrees to:

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"(a) Store and display the foods separately from other foods; and

"(b) Clearly indicate in displaying the foods that the foods are homemade and not pre-9 pared in an inspected food establishment. 10

11 "[(4)(a)] (6)(a) Except as provided in this paragraph, the label statement required under subsection (2) of this section is 'This product is homemade, [and] is not prepared in an inspected food 1213establishment and must be stored and displayed separately if merchandised by a retailer.' The State Department of Agriculture may adopt rules specifying alternative wording for the label state-14 15ment to the extent that alternative wording is necessary in order to comply with federal require-16 ments.

17(b) In addition to the statement required under paragraph (a) of this subsection, the label 18 [*shall*] **must** disclose the following product information:

19 "(A) The name[,] **and** phone number [and address] for the food establishment;

"(B) The address of the food establishment or the unique identification number for the 2021food establishment provided under subsection (7) of this section;

22"[(B)] (C) The name of the product;

23"(C)] (**D**) The ingredients of the product in descending order by weight;

"(D)] (E) The net weight or net volume of the product; 24

25(E) (F) Any applicable allergen warnings as specified under federal labeling requirements; 26[and]

27[(F)] (G) If the label provides any nutrient content claim, health claim or other nutritional information, product nutritional information as described in federal labeling requirements; and 28

"(H) The presence of pets in the residential dwelling in which the food establishment is 2930 located, if any, and the potential for pet allergens.

"(7) At the request of a food establishment described in subsection (2) of this section, the 3132department shall provide to the food establishment a unique identification number that the 33 food establishment may use on the label of a product under subsection (6) of this section. 34The department may establish and collect a reasonable fee to cover the cost of administering 35 this subsection.

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"[(5)] (8) Notwithstanding subsection (2) of this section, the department may require a food es-37 tablishment described in subsection (2) of this section to become licensed under ORS 616.695 to 38 616.755, if the food establishment refuses to comply with department rules requiring that the food establishment be constructed and maintained in a clean, healthful and sanitary condition. 39

40 "[(6) The department may adopt rules increasing the food sales limit established in subsection (2) 41 of this section by an amount that reflects changes in the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers, West Region (All Items), as published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics of the United States 4243 Department of Labor. The State Department of Agriculture may not adopt rules decreasing the food 44 sales limit established in subsection (2) of this section.]

(9) The department shall adjust annually the maximum dollar amount of annual gross 45

1 sales described in subsection (2)(d) of this section.

"(10) The department may not prohibit a food establishment located in a residential dwelling, including a food establishment licensed as a domestic kitchen, from selling foods on the basis that there are pets in the residential dwelling. The department shall prohibit pets from being in the food preparation area.

6 "[(7)] (11) A person operating a food establishment described in **subsection** (2) of this section 7 must maintain accurate records of annual sales and the types of foods produced by the food estab-8 lishment. The person must retain the records for not less than three years and make the records 9 available for inspection by the department upon request.".

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
