Senate Bill 648

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.**

Prohibits counties from allowing use of certain new dwellings on resource lands as vacation occupancies.

1	A BILL FOR AN ACT
2	Relating to vacation occupancies on resource lands.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2023 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 215.
5	SECTION 2. A county may not allow a dwelling or any part of a dwelling to be used as
6	a vacation occupancy, as defined in ORS 90.100, if the dwelling:
7	(1) Was constructed on or after January 1, 2024;
8	(2) Is on lands zoned for forest use, mixed farm and forest use or exclusive farm use;
9	(3) Is not a replacement dwelling, as described in ORS 215.291 or 215.755 (1), for a dwelling
10	constructed before January 1, 2024;
11	(4) Is not a bed and breakfast allowed under ORS 215.449 (3), 215.451 (3), 215.452 (13) or
12	215.453 (12) or lodging for a guest ranch allowed under ORS 215.461; and
13	(5) Is not a dwelling established under ORS 215.705, 215.740, 215.750 or 215.755.
