

Senate Bill 671

Sponsored by Senator KNOPP (at the request of Brandon Ferris) (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Transportation to provide walk-in appointments for written driver license test.

Directs department to offer drive test appointments at all hours field offices are open to public.

2 Relating to driver license testing.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Transportation shall offer the option of walk-in ap-**
5 **pointments for the written Class C driver license test.**

6 **(2) Drive test appointments, at field offices of the department, must be offered during**
7 **all hours the field office is open to the public. This subsection applies only to field offices that**
8 **provide drive tests.**
