

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 678

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 17, after “That” insert “a meaningful share of the”.

2 In line 20, after “That” insert “, to the extent practicable,”.

3 In line 25, delete “any”.

4 Delete lines 26 and 27 and insert:

5 **“SECTION 2. (1) The Department of Land Conservation and Development, through the**
6 **Oregon Coastal Management Program, shall conduct outreach and engage and coordinate**
7 **with state agencies, local governments and affected communities to carry out the policies**
8 **described in section 1 of this 2023 Act and subsection (2) of this section.**

9 **“(2) It is the policy of the State of Oregon to:**

10 **“(a) Support ongoing engagement between offshore wind energy developers and, at a**
11 **minimum, the following:**

12 **“(A) Affected communities, including coastal, fishing and tribal communities, including**
13 **the Confederated Tribes of Coos, Lower Umpqua and Siuslaw Indians and the Coquille Indian**
14 **Tribe; and**

15 **“(B) Community and regional organizations and agencies, including:**

16 **“(i) Southern Oregon Ocean Resources Coalition;**

17 **“(ii) Pacific Fishery Management Council;**

18 **“(iii) Southwestern Oregon Workforce Investment Board;**

19 **“(iv) Oregon International Port of Coos Bay; and**

20 **“(v) The Port of Brookings Harbor;**

21 **“(b) Minimize and mitigate any adverse effects of survey activity related to offshore wind**
22 **leasing while maximizing benefits from offshore wind energy development for local and re-**
23 **gional:**

24 **“(A) Communities, including coastal, fishing and tribal communities;**

25 **“(B) Ecosystems and environments; and**

26 **“(C) Economies, including Oregon’s fishing industry; and**

27 **“(c) Promote economic diversification and resilience through, at a minimum:**

28 **“(A) Apprenticeships, workforce training and development;**

29 **“(B) Use of prevailing wages, apprenticeship utilization and project labor agreements;**

30 **“(C) For work that is not construction, use of labor peace agreements;**

31 **“(D) Use of community benefit agreements; and**

32 **“(E) Local and regional supply chain investments.**

33 **“(3) The department shall conduct, or support, federal consistency reviews of offshore**
34 **wind leasing decisions and related actions related to offshore wind development off of the**
35 **Oregon coast made by the federal Bureau of Ocean Energy Management.**

1 “(4) The department may engage a consultant to support the department in carrying out
2 the provisions of this section.

3 “**SECTION 3.** (1) The Department of Land Conservation and Development shall draft a
4 report that summarizes the department’s activities in carrying out section 2 of this 2023 Act,
5 reviews state policies related to offshore wind development and provides recommendations
6 for improving state policies or further agency action.

7 “(2) The department shall submit the report described in subsection (1) of this section in
8 the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to
9 the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to energy and development no
10 later than December 31, 2024.

11 “**SECTION 4.** Section 3 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 2025.

12 “**SECTION 5.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appro-
13 priated to the Department of Land Conservation and Development, for the biennium begin-
14 ning July 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$250,000, for the purpose of
15 carrying out sections 2 and 3 of this 2023 Act.”.

16 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 28.

17 In line 29, delete “4” and insert “6”.
