

Senate Bill 757

Sponsored by Senator GELSER BLOUIN

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires that whenever notice of founded disposition of child abuse is delivered to perpetrator, notice must also be delivered to perpetrator's attorney, if applicable.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to notices of founded disposition of report of child abuse.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Whenever an investigation conducted under ORS 419B.020 results in a notice**
5 **of founded disposition being delivered to the person identified as the perpetrator in the**
6 **founded disposition, the notice must also be provided to the person's attorney, if applicable.**

7 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2023 Act applies to notices delivered on or after the effec-**
8 **tive date of this 2023 Act.**
