

## HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 789

1 On page 2 of the printed bill, after line 7, insert:

2 **“SECTION 3. (1) As used in this section, ‘canola’ and ‘Willamette Valley Protected Dis-**  
3 **trict’ have the meanings given those terms in section 1 of this 2023 Act.**

4 **“(2) On or before September 30, 2023, the State Department of Agriculture shall report,**  
5 **in the manner prescribed in ORS 192.245, to a committee or interim committee of the House**  
6 **of Representatives related to agriculture on recommendations for legislation to establish a**  
7 **program that identifies fields in the Willamette Valley Protected District that produce seed**  
8 **crops of the genus Brassica in order to mitigate conflicts related to the production of seed**  
9 **crops of the genus Brassica.**

10 **“(3) The report may include, but need not be limited to:**

11 **“(a) A discussion of a pinning map of the production of seed crops of the genus Brassica**  
12 **in the Willamette Valley Protected District that is operated by the department and accessible**  
13 **to the public, including a discussion of the potential costs for the implementation and ongo-**  
14 **ing management of the pinning map.**

15 **“(b) Recommendations for geographic or acreage limitations on the production of seed**  
16 **crops of the genus Brassica in the Willamette Valley Protected District.**

17 **“(c) Any changes to provisions of law, or new provisions of law, including provisions**  
18 **concerning the department’s authority, that are needed to implement the recommendations.**

19 **“(4) To help inform the report, the department shall convene a work group of relevant**  
20 **stakeholders, including, but not limited to:**

21 **“(a) Organic, specialty and other producers of seed crops of the genus Brassica;**

22 **“(b) Canola growers; and**

23 **“(c) Subject matter experts connected to research and technical assistance at Oregon**  
24 **State University.**

25 **“SECTION 4. Sections 1 and 3 of this 2023 Act are repealed on July 1, 2024.”.**

26 In line 8, delete “3” and insert “5”.

27
