SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Changes expenditure limitation for grant to Port of Port Orford [*for seafood hub redevelopment project*] to biennium beginning July 1, 2023. **Modifies purpose of grant.**
Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2023.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to Port of Port Orford; amending section 211, chapter 669, Oregon Laws 2021; and declaring
3 an emergency.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** Section 211, chapter 669, Oregon Laws 2021, is amended to read:

6 **Sec. 211.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, [*the limitation on expenditures*
7 *established by section 3 (5), chapter __, Oregon Laws 2021 (Enrolled House Bill 5023),*] **the amount**
8 **of \$1,600,000 is established** for the biennium beginning July 1, [2021] **2023**, as the maximum limit
9 for payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Economic
10 Development Fund to the Oregon Business Development Department, for infrastructure, [*is increased*
11 *by \$1,600,000,*] for a grant to the Port of Port Orford for [*a seafood hub redevelopment project*] **port**
12 **redevelopment projects, including crane replacement and a seawater delivery system.**

13 **SECTION 2.** **This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
14 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect**
15 **July 1, 2023.**
