AN ACT

Relating to high school credits earned outside the United States.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

- SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Education shall conduct a study to identify how to improve processes to more easily and accurately transfer to high schools in this state any high school credits earned by a student outside the United States.
- (2) The department shall submit a report in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to education no later than September 15, 2024.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 2025.
