

## SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 962

By COMMITTEE ON VETERANS, EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT, FEDERAL AND WORLD  
AFFAIRS

1 Delete lines 11 through 14 of the printed bill and insert:

2 “(a) The county is one of Clatsop, Coos, Curry, Douglas, Lane, Lincoln or Tillamook Counties;  
3 and

4 “(b) The emergency management agency of the county is funded by federal moneys distributed  
5 through the Emergency Management Performance Grant administered by the Federal Emergency  
6 Management Agency.”.

7 After line 26, insert:

8 “**SECTION 3. (1) The Emergency Preparedness Advisory Council established under sec-**  
9 **tion 151, chapter 539, Oregon Laws 2021, shall convene a Committee on County Emergency**  
10 **Management.**

11 “**(2) The committee must consist of not more than half of the members of the council.**  
12 **The council shall appoint a chairperson and vice chairperson for the committee.**

13 “**(3) The committee shall study and make recommendations regarding the capacity of**  
14 **counties in Oregon to prepare for, respond to and recover from emergencies. The recom-**  
15 **mendations must include recommendations for methods to establish dedicated funding for**  
16 **county emergency management staff, including at least a director and deputy director of**  
17 **emergency management in each county.**

18 “**(4) On or before December 31, 2024, the committee shall transmit a report describing its**  
19 **findings and recommendations to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly relat-**  
20 **ing to emergency management.**

21 “**(5) The Legislative Revenue Officer is directed to assist the Committee on County**  
22 **Emergency Management in carrying out revenue projections and any other tasks the com-**  
23 **mittee deems necessary for the performance of its duties.**

24 “**SECTION 4. Section 3 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 2026.”.**  
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
