PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2706

- On page 1 of the printed bill, line 3, after "ORS" insert "348.272 and".
- Delete lines 5 through 31 and delete page 2 and insert:
- 3 "SECTION 1. ORS 350.300, as amended by section 2, chapter 42, Oregon
- 4 Laws 2022, is amended to read:
- 5 "350.300. (1) Notwithstanding ORS 341.290, 352.105 or 353.050, a student
- 6 who is a current foster child or former foster child or a current homeless
- 7 youth or former homeless youth, under 25 years of age and enrolled in
- 8 courses totaling one or more credit hours at an institution of higher educa-
- 9 tion as an undergraduate student shall have the amount of tuition and all
- 10 fees levied against the student waived if attending an institution of higher
- education for purposes of pursuing an initial undergraduate degree.
- "(2) A student is entitled to waiver of tuition and all fees under sub-
- section (1) of this section until the student has received the equivalent of
- 14 four years of undergraduate education.
- 15 "(3) As a condition of receiving a tuition waiver for an academic year, the
- student must complete and submit the Free Application for Federal Student
- 17 Aid (FAFSA) for that academic year.
- 18 "(4) A waiver of tuition and all fees under subsection (1) of this section
- may be reduced by the amount of any federal aid scholarships or grants, an
- 20 award from the Oregon Opportunity Grant program established under ORS
- 21 348.205 and any other aid received from the institution of higher education.

- 1 For the purposes of this subsection, 'federal aid scholarships or grants' does
- 2 not include Chafee Educational and Training Voucher Program grants under
- 3 42 U.S.C. 677.
- 4 "(5) As used in this section:
- 5 "(a) 'Former foster child' means an individual who, for a total of 18 or
- 6 more months while under 14 years of age or a total of six or more months
- 7 while between 14 and 21 years of age, was:
- 8 "(A) A ward of the court pursuant to ORS 419B.100 (1)(b) to (e), in the
- 9 legal custody of the Department of Human Services for out-of-home place-
- ment [and not dismissed from care before reaching 16 years of age]; or
- "(B) An Indian child subject to ORS 419B.600 to 419B.654, under the ju-
- risdiction of a tribal court for out-of-home placement [and not dismissed from
- care before reaching 16 years of age].
- "(b) 'Homeless youth' means a person who:
- 15 "(A) Experienced homelessness for a total of six or more months while
- between 14 and 24 years of age;
- "(B) While experiencing homelessness as described in subparagraph (A)
- of this paragraph, received services from an organization contracted by the
- 19 Department of Human Services to provide services to homeless persons or
- 20 from a host home, as defined by the department by rule; and
- 21 "(C) Was at least 16 years of age when the person last received the ser-
- vices described in subparagraph (B) of this paragraph.
- 23 "(c) 'Institution of higher education' means:
- "(A) A public university listed in ORS 352.002;
- 25 "(B) A community college operated under ORS chapter 341; [or]
- ²⁶ "(C) A career school, as defined in ORS 345.010; or
- "(C)] (**D**) The Oregon Health and Science University.
- **"SECTION 2.** ORS 348.272 is amended to read:
- 29 "348.272. (1) As used in this section:
- "(a) 'Former foster child' has the meaning given that term in ORS 350.300.

- "(b) 'Institution of higher education' means:
- "(A) A public university listed in ORS 352.002[,];
- "(B) The Oregon Health and Science University[,];
- 4 "(C) A career school, as defined in ORS 345.010;
- 5 "(D) A community college operated under ORS chapter 341; or
- 6 "(E) An Oregon-based, regionally accredited independent institution.
- 7 "(2) In addition to any other scholarships provided by law, the Higher
- 8 Education Coordinating Commission shall award scholarships to any indi-
- 9 vidual applying for enrollment or enrolled in an institution of higher edu-
- 10 cation who is a current foster child or former foster child.

- "(3) Scholarships awarded under this section shall be in an amount to be determined by the commission based on the funds that are made available for the awarding year.
- "(4) If a student who is a current foster child or former foster child continues to remain enrolled in a public university listed in ORS 352.002, a community college or an Oregon-based, regionally accredited independent institution, the student is entitled to apply for renewal of the scholarship until the student has received the equivalent of four years of undergraduate education.
- "(5) The Director of the Office of Student Access and Completion may require proof that a student is a current foster child or former foster child.
- "SECTION 3. The amendments to ORS 348.272 and 350.300 by sections 1 and 2 of this 2023 Act apply to tuition and fees assessed on and after the effective date of this 2023 Act.".
