**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 531**

1 Delete lines 4 through 20 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2023 Act is added to and made a part**
3 **of ORS chapter 327.**

4 **“SECTION 2. (1) The Summer and After-School Learning and**
5 **Enrichment Grant Program is established for the purpose of providing**
6 **grants to:**

7 **“(a) School districts, education service districts and public charter**
8 **schools for summer and after-school learning and enrichment pro-**
9 **grams for youth in kindergarten through grade 12; and**

10 **“(b) A fiscal agent for distribution to federally recognized Indian**
11 **tribes in this state, community-based organizations and other organ-**
12 **izations providing expanded learning or enrichment opportunities for**
13 **summer and after-school learning and enrichment programs for youth**
14 **in kindergarten through grade 12.**

15 **“(2) The Department of Education shall administer the grant pro-**
16 **gram established by this section by:**

17 **“(a) Proposing quality and oversight standards for summer and**
18 **after-school learning and enrichment programs for adoption by rule**
19 **by the State Board of Education. For the purpose of this paragraph,**
20 **the department shall regularly consult with school districts, education**
21 **service districts, public charter schools, federally recognized Indian**

1 tribes, community-based organizations and other organizations pro-
2 viding expanded learning or enrichment opportunities.

3 “(b) Implementing a process for awarding grants that:

4 “(A) Prioritizes funding for summer and after-school learning and
5 enrichment programs that serve youth from rural areas or historically
6 underserved populations, including youth with disabilities and foster
7 youth.

8 “(B) Encourages and supports partnerships between school districts,
9 education service districts, public charter schools, federally recognized
10 Indian tribes, community-based organizations and other organizations
11 that provide expanded learning or enrichment opportunities.

12 “(C) Aligns outcomes of existing programs, organizations or ser-
13 vices provided to youth or for the benefit of youth.

14 “(D) Is open, transparent and inclusive and, when possible, ad-
15 dresses administrative barriers that limit or prevent community-
16 based, culturally responsive summer and after-school learning and
17 enrichment programs from accessing grant funding.

18 “(3) The State Board of Education may adopt any rules necessary
19 for the administration of this section.

20 “SECTION 3. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
21 ation, there is appropriated to the Department of Education, for the
22 biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount
23 of \$_____, for the Summer and After-School Learning and
24 Enrichment Grant Program established under section 2 of this 2023
25 Act.

26 “SECTION 4. This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate
27 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
28 declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect July 1, 2023.”.

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
