1 On page 2 of the printed bill, after line 10, insert:

2 **"SECTION 3. (1) As used in this section:**

"(a) 'Detention facility' has the meaning given that term in ORS
4 419A.004.

5 "(b) 'Medical assistance' has the meaning given that term in ORS
6 414.025.

7 "(c) 'Youth correction facility' has the meaning given that term in
8 ORS 420.005.

9 "(2) The Oregon Health Authority may not terminate medical as-10 sistance for a youth who is placed in a detention facility pending ad-11 judication with respect to coverage for:

12 "(a) Screenings;

13 **"(b) Diagnostic services;**

14 "(c) Referrals for health care services; and

15 "(d) Case management services.

"(3) An adjudicated youth who is otherwise eligible for medical assistance but for being held in a youth correction facility or detention, shall be determined eligible for medical assistance up to 30 days prior to the youth's date of release with respect to coverage of the services described in subsection (1) of this section.".

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
