PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 401

1 Delete lines 4 through 8 of the printed bill and insert:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Oregon Health Authority shall study tardive
dyskinesia and other related involuntary movement disorders. The
study must:

5 "(a) Analyze existing resources for patients, providers and 6 caregivers in this state.

"(b) Identify opportunities to expand existing resources for patients,
providers and caregivers in this state.

9 "(c) Develop recommendations to ensure minority populations have
10 equitable access to existing and expanded resources for patients, pro11 viders and caregivers in this state.

"(d) Explain the authority's strategic plan to implement the oppor tunities identified under paragraph (b) of this subsection and the rec ommendations developed under paragraph (c) of this subsection.

"(2) The authority shall provide the results of the study in a report
 to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to pub lic health and health care in the manner provided under ORS 192.245
 no later than September 15, 2024.

"SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2,
2025.".

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
