

Requested by JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 5019**

1 Delete lines 4 through 15 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-**
3 **ation, there is appropriated to the Housing and Community Services**
4 **Department, for the biennium ending June 30, 2023, out of the General**
5 **Fund, the amount of \$7,386,826 for homelessness prevention services**
6 **delivered through the Oregon Eviction Diversion and Prevention and**
7 **Eviction Prevention Rapid Response programs.**

8 **“SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-**
9 **ation, there is appropriated to the Housing and Community Services**
10 **Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the Gen-**
11 **eral Fund, the amount of \$26,213,174 for homelessness prevention ser-**
12 **vices delivered through the Oregon Eviction Diversion and Prevention**
13 **and Eviction Prevention Rapid Response programs.**

14 **“SECTION 3. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-**
15 **ation, there is appropriated to the Housing and Community Services**
16 **Department, for the biennium ending June 30, 2023, out of the General**
17 **Fund, the amount of \$200,000 for the development and design of a**
18 **statewide, long-term rent assistance program for individuals who are**
19 **rehoused with state investments made by sections 4 and 5 of this 2023**
20 **Act.**

21 **“SECTION 4. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-**

1 ation, there is appropriated to the Housing and Community Services
2 Department, for the biennium ending June 30, 2023, out of the General
3 Fund, the amount of \$20,900,000 to increase shelter capacity and con-
4 nections to shelter, support rapid rehousing initiatives, provide ca-
5 pacity support for culturally responsive organizations and provide
6 sanitation services for communities in designated homelessness emer-
7 gency areas, based on local plans submitted to the department.

8 **“SECTION 5.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
9 ation, there is appropriated to the Housing and Community Services
10 Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the Gen-
11 eral Fund, the amount of \$64,300,000 to increase shelter capacity and
12 connections to shelter, support rapid rehousing initiatives, provide
13 capacity support for culturally responsive organizations and provide
14 sanitation services for communities in designated homelessness emer-
15 gency areas, based on local plans submitted to the department.

16 **“SECTION 6.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
17 ation, there is appropriated to the Housing and Community Services
18 Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the Gen-
19 eral Fund, the amount of \$5,000,000 to provide support to members of
20 federally recognized Indian tribes in Oregon experiencing
21 homelessness.

22 **“SECTION 7.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
23 ation, there is appropriated to the Housing and Community Services
24 Department, for the biennium ending June 30, 2023, out of the General
25 Fund, the amount of \$1,125,824 for the administration of homelessness
26 prevention programs and local plans addressing unsheltered
27 homelessness in designated homelessness emergency areas.

28 **“SECTION 8.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
29 ation, there is appropriated to the Housing and Community Services
30 Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the Gen-

1 eral Fund, the amount of \$1,145,303 for the administration of
2 homelessness prevention programs and local plans addressing unshel-
3 tered homelessness in designated homelessness emergency areas.

4 **“SECTION 9.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
5 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Emergency
6 Management, for the biennium ending June 30, 2023, out of the Gen-
7 eral Fund, the amount of \$923,925 for the coordination of efforts to
8 address homelessness in designated homelessness emergency areas as
9 part of the activation of the State of Oregon Emergency Operations
10 Plan.

11 **“SECTION 10.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
12 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Emergency
13 Management, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the
14 General Fund, the amount of \$722,631 for the coordination of efforts
15 to address homelessness in designated homelessness emergency areas
16 as part of the activation of the State of Oregon Emergency Operations
17 Plan.

18 **“SECTION 11.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
19 ation, there is appropriated to the Housing and Community Services
20 Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the Gen-
21 eral Fund, the amount of \$26,135,000 to increase shelter capacity and
22 connections to shelter, support rapid rehousing initiatives, provide
23 capacity support for culturally responsive organizations and provide
24 sanitation services for communities within the OR-505 - Oregon Bal-
25 ance of State Continuum of Care.

26 **“SECTION 12.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
27 ation, there is appropriated to the Housing and Community Services
28 Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the Gen-
29 eral Fund, the amount of \$1,250,000 for the administration of support
30 provided to address homelessness in communities within the OR-505 -

1 Oregon Balance of State Continuum of Care.

2 **“SECTION 13.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
3 ation, there is appropriated to the Housing and Community Services
4 Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the Gen-
5 eral Fund, the amount of \$5,000,000 for deposit into the Emergency
6 Housing Account created under ORS 458.620, for the purpose of pro-
7 viding services and assistance to school-aged children enrolled in
8 kindergarten through grade 12 who are homeless or at risk of becom-
9 ing homeless, or their families.

10 **“SECTION 14.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
11 the amount of \$5,000,000 is established for the biennium beginning July
12 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the Housing
13 and Community Services Department from the Emergency Housing
14 Account created under ORS 458.620 for the purpose of providing ser-
15 vices and assistance to school-aged children enrolled in kindergarten
16 through grade 12 who are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless,
17 or their families.

18 **“SECTION 15.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
19 ation, there is appropriated to the Housing and Community Services
20 Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the Gen-
21 eral Fund, the amount of \$200,854, for administration of the provision
22 of services and assistance to school-aged children enrolled in
23 kindergarten through grade 12 who are homeless or at risk of becom-
24 ing homeless, or their families.

25 **“SECTION 16.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
26 ation, there is appropriated to the Department of Human Services, for
27 the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the
28 amount of \$12,500,000 for the purpose of awarding grants to increase
29 access by youth experiencing homelessness to shelter facilities, out-
30 reach, culturally specific services and mental health or substance

1 abuse services and to strengthen partnerships with host home pro-
2 grams and other transitional housing options.

3 **“SECTION 17.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
4 ation, there is appropriated to the Department of Human Services, for
5 the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the
6 amount of \$6,250,000 for the purpose of providing two-year grants to
7 organizations operating host home projects to establish, continue or
8 expand operation of host home projects for youth experiencing
9 homelessness.

10 **“SECTION 18.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
11 ation, there is appropriated to the Department of Human Services, for
12 the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the
13 amount of \$1,171,469, for the administration of programs and services
14 for youth experiencing homelessness.

15 **“SECTION 19.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the
16 General Fund appropriation made to the Housing and Community
17 Services Department by section 229, chapter 669, Oregon Laws 2021, for
18 the biennium ending June 30, 2023, for distributions to compensate
19 landlords for unpaid rent payments pursuant to sections 12 and 13,
20 chapter 420, Oregon Laws 2021, is decreased by \$16,623,741.

21 **“SECTION 20.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the
22 General Fund appropriation made to the Housing and Community
23 Services Department by section 1, chapter 556, Oregon Laws 2021, for
24 the biennium ending June 30, 2023, is decreased by \$14,000,000.

25 **“SECTION 21.** This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate
26 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
27 declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect on its passage.”.

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
