PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2574

- On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 13 and insert:
- "SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, 'hospital' has the meaning
- 3 given that term in ORS 442.015, excluding special inpatient care facil-
- 4 ities as defined by the Oregon Health Authority by rule.
- 5 "(2) A hospital licensed under ORS 441.025 must:
- 6 "(a) Adopt a policy for the dispensing of human immunodeficiency
- 7 virus post-exposure prophylaxis drugs or therapies; and
- 8 "(b) Have procedures in place to ensure that hospital staff dispense
- 9 to a patient, with a patient's informed consent, at least a five-day
- 10 supply of human immunodeficiency virus post-exposure prophylactic
- 11 drugs or therapies following the patient's possible exposure to human
- 12 immunodeficiency virus, unless medically contraindicated.
- 13 "(3) The hospital policy adopted under this section must in all re-
- 14 spects, other than as specified in subsection (2) of this section, con-
- 15 form to guidelines issued by the Centers for Disease Control and
- 16 **Prevention.**".
- Delete lines 17 through 24 and insert:
- 18 "(2) Once each calendar year, the Oregon Health Authority shall provide
- to each type A hospital and to each type B hospital in this state, at no cost
- to the hospital, one 30-day supply of human immunodeficiency virus post-
- exposure prophylactic drugs or therapies, unless declined by the hospital.".

- On page 2, line 9, delete "five-day".
- In line 10, delete "supplies of".

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
