**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 889**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 18 through 31.

2 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 6 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 2. ORS 821.040 is amended to read:**

4 “821.040. (1) A person commits the offense of operation of an off-road ve-  
5 hicle without required equipment if the person is operating a vehicle de-  
6 scribed in ORS 821.010 in an area described in ORS 821.020 and the vehicle  
7 is not equipped in compliance with all of the following:

8 “(a) The vehicle must be equipped with a muffler that meets the standards  
9 for noise emissions established under ORS 821.030.

10 “(b) The vehicle must be equipped with brakes that meet the requirements  
11 established under ORS 821.030.

12 “[*(c) The vehicle must be equipped with a windshield wiper if the vehicle*  
13 *is equipped with a windshield.*]

14 **“(c) When the vehicle is operated on a highway and the vehicle is**  
15 **equipped with a windshield, the top edge of which is at least six inches**  
16 **above the steering wheel, the vehicle must be equipped with a**  
17 **windshield wiper.**

18 **“(d) When the vehicle is operated off the highway and the vehicle**  
19 **is equipped with a windshield, the windshield must be unobstructed.**

20 “[*(d)*] **(e)** When the vehicle is operated on sand, the vehicle must be  
21 equipped with a flag that meets the requirements established under ORS

1 821.030.

2 “[*e*] (f) The vehicle must be equipped with any safety equipment required  
3 under ORS 821.030.

4 “[*f*] (g) At any time from one-half hour after sunset to one-half hour  
5 after sunrise, the vehicle must be equipped with and display headlights and  
6 taillights.

7 “(2) Motorcycles and mopeds are not required by this section to be  
8 equipped with windshield wipers.

9 “(3) The offense described in this section, operation of off-road vehicle  
10 without required equipment, is a Class C traffic violation.”.
