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PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 704

On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 30 and delete page 2 2.

On page 3, delete lines 1 through 32 and insert:

"SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Health Policy Board, or an advisory committee appointed by the board, shall examine and evaluate the cost and feasibility of ensuring access to health care by residents of this state who are not enrolled in publicly funded health care programs, qualified health plans offered through Oregon's health insurance exchange or other commercial health insurance, by implementing the recommendations contained in:

- "(a) The report approved on September 29, 2022, by the Task Force on Universal Health Care established under section 2, chapter 629, Oregon Laws 2019; or
- 14 "(b) The Oregon Health Authority Public Option Implementation 15 Report, dated January 2022.
- "(2) The board shall also explore incentives to encourage individuals
 who are eligible for publicly funded health care programs, qualified
 health plans offered through Oregon's health insurance exchange or
 other commercial insurance to enroll in the programs, plans or insurance.
 - "(3) No later than September 15, 2024, the board shall report, in the

- manner provided in ORS 192.245, the board's or committee's findings,
- 2 with recommendations for legislation if needed, to the interim com-
- 3 mittees of the Legislative Assembly related to health.".
