PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 847

On page 30 of the printed bill, after line 24, insert: 1 2 **"LIABILITY-PROTECTED SAFE RESTING PLACES AND** 3 CAMPGROUNDS 4 5 "SECTION 28. (1) This section applies to: 6 "(a) Any city or county located within the Rural Oregon Continuum 7 of Care that establishes a liability-protected safe resting place or 8 campground for homeless individuals that has the characteristics and 9 provides the services listed in subsection (2) of this section; 10 "(b) The respective city or county officers, whether elected or ap-11 pointed, and the city or county employees and other agents; and 12 "(c) A third-party entity that has entered into an agreement with 13 the city or county to maintain and operate a liability-protected safe 14 resting place or campground on behalf of the city or county. 15"(2) A liability-protected safe resting place or campground: 16 "(a) May not be situated in an area that would pose an obvious 17 danger to occupants, including, but not limited to, areas near high-18 ways, overpasses, underpasses, ramps, waterways that are prone to 19 flooding and known polluted or contaminated areas; 20"(b) Must be easily accessible to law enforcement and emergency 21

1 personnel and their vehicles;

"(c) Must be designed to cordon off a separate allotment for each
occupant, which must be at least 10 feet by 10 feet in area;

4 "(d) Must be graded or otherwise allows for adequate stormwater
5 drainage;

"(e) Must provide occupants with access to sanitary facilities, including toilets, and hand washing stations and trash disposal facilities;

9 "(f) Must have signage that is easily visible and printed in English
10 and Spanish and that sets forth, at a minimum, the following:

"(A) That individuals occupying the liability-protected safe resting
 space or campground do so voluntarily and at their own risk;

"(B) If there is no on-site staff, that the liability-protected safe
 resting place or campground does not have an on-site manager;

15 "(C) A contact phone number for emergency personnel;

"(D) The location of the toilets and trash disposal facilities; and
"(E) The day of the week on which trash is picked up and transported offsite.

"(3) Notwithstanding ORS 30.265, an occupant or other individual
 may not bring a civil claim against a person listed in subsection (1)
 of this section for any harm, including, but not limited to, property
 damage, personal injury or death, that arises out of:

"(a) The occupant or other individual's use of a liability-protected
safe resting place or campground established, maintained or operated
by the person;

26 "(b) The removal or expulsion of the occupant or other individual 27 from a liability-protected safe resting place or campground based on 28 aggressive behavior, substance abuse or violation of a criminal law; 29 or

30 "(c) The implementation and enforcement of reasonable rules at a
