**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 847**

1 On page 30 of the printed bill, after line 24, insert:

2  
3 **“LIABILITY-PROTECTED SAFE RESTING PLACES AND**  
4 **CAMPGROUNDS**

5  
6 **“SECTION 28. (1) This section applies to:**

7 **“(a) Any city or county located within the Rural Oregon Continuum**  
8 **of Care that establishes a liability-protected safe resting place or**  
9 **campground for homeless individuals that has the characteristics and**  
10 **provides the services listed in subsection (2) of this section;**

11 **“(b) The respective city or county officers, whether elected or ap-**  
12 **pointed, and the city or county employees and other agents; and**

13 **“(c) A third-party entity that has entered into an agreement with**  
14 **the city or county to maintain and operate a liability-protected safe**  
15 **resting place or campground on behalf of the city or county.**

16 **“(2) A liability-protected safe resting place or campground:**

17 **“(a) May not be situated in an area that would pose an obvious**  
18 **danger to occupants, including, but not limited to, areas near high-**  
19 **ways, overpasses, underpasses, ramps, waterways that are prone to**  
20 **flooding and known polluted or contaminated areas;**

21 **“(b) Must be easily accessible to law enforcement and emergency**

1 **personnel and their vehicles;**

2 **“(c) Must be designed to cordon off a separate allotment for each**  
3 **occupant, which must be at least 10 feet by 10 feet in area;**

4 **“(d) Must be graded or otherwise allows for adequate stormwater**  
5 **drainage;**

6 **“(e) Must provide occupants with access to sanitary facilities, in-**  
7 **cluding toilets, and hand washing stations and trash disposal facilities;**  
8 **and**

9 **“(f) Must have signage that is easily visible and printed in English**  
10 **and Spanish and that sets forth, at a minimum, the following:**

11 **“(A) That individuals occupying the liability-protected safe resting**  
12 **space or campground do so voluntarily and at their own risk;**

13 **“(B) If there is no on-site staff, that the liability-protected safe**  
14 **resting place or campground does not have an on-site manager;**

15 **“(C) A contact phone number for emergency personnel;**

16 **“(D) The location of the toilets and trash disposal facilities; and**

17 **“(E) The day of the week on which trash is picked up and trans-**  
18 **ported offsite.**

19 **“(3) Notwithstanding ORS 30.265, an occupant or other individual**  
20 **may not bring a civil claim against a person listed in subsection (1)**  
21 **of this section for any harm, including, but not limited to, property**  
22 **damage, personal injury or death, that arises out of:**

23 **“(a) The occupant or other individual’s use of a liability-protected**  
24 **safe resting place or campground established, maintained or operated**  
25 **by the person;**

26 **“(b) The removal or expulsion of the occupant or other individual**  
27 **from a liability-protected safe resting place or campground based on**  
28 **aggressive behavior, substance abuse or violation of a criminal law;**  
29 **or**

30 **“(c) The implementation and enforcement of reasonable rules at a**

1 **liability-protected safe resting place or campground intended to mini-**  
2 **mize conflicts among occupants and other individuals.”.**

3 In line 28, delete “28” and insert “29”.

4 In line 34, delete “29” and insert “30” and delete “3 and 5” and insert  
5 “3, 5 and 28”.

6 In line 44, delete “30” and insert “31”.

7 On page 31, line 1, delete “31” and insert “32”.

8 In line 4, delete “32” and insert “33”.

9 In line 7, delete “29” and insert “30”.

10 In line 10, delete “29” and insert “30”.

11 In line 11, delete “33” and insert “34”.

12 In line 38, delete “34” and insert “35”.

13 On page 32, line 29, delete “35” and insert “36”.

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
