- 7 of any statutory provision unless discovery of the evidence resulted from
- 8 a violation of ORS 131.615, 181A.250 or 810.410 or exclusion of the evidence
- 9 is required by:
- "(1) The United States Constitution or the Oregon Constitution;
- 11 "(2) The rules of evidence governing privileges and the admission of 12 hearsay; or
- "(3) The rights of the press.
 - "SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 136.432 by section 1 of this 2023 Act apply to criminal and juvenile proceedings initiated on or after the effective date of this 2023 Act.".
