**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 1044**

1 Delete lines 4 through 11 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-**  
3 **ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the**  
4 **biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount**  
5 **of \$74,200,000, which shall be expended as follows:**

6 **“(1) \$6,000,000 for transition case management for individuals dis-**  
7 **charged from the Oregon State Hospital who are at risk of**  
8 **homelessness;**

9 **“(2) \$10,000,000 for community mental health programs to provide**  
10 **outreach to, treatment for and engagement of individuals with mental**  
11 **illness for whom civil commitment proceedings have been initiated**  
12 **under ORS 426.070 and after civil commitment proceedings have been**  
13 **dismissed, if needed to provide stability to the individuals and give**  
14 **them access to treatment;**

15 **“(3) \$4,900,000 for community mental health programs to expand jail**  
16 **diversion services;**

17 **“(4) \$2,300,000 to expand children’s psychiatric residential treatment**  
18 **capacity;**

19 **“(5) \$8,300,000 to:**

20 **“(a) Expand access to behavioral rehabilitation services to all med-**  
21 **ical assistance recipients in need of the services; and**

1       **“(b) Support the expansion of service hubs for youth who are tran-**  
2 **sitioning to adulthood;**

3       **“(6) \$7,700,000 to expand child and adult suicide prevention, inter-**  
4 **vention and post-intervention services to reduce suicides in this state;**

5       **“(7) \$15,000,000 for substance use disorder facilities and recovery**  
6 **centers; and**

7       **“(8) \$20,000,000 for the health care provider incentive program cre-**  
8 **ated in ORS 676.454 to recruit and retain diverse health care providers**  
9 **and attract providers to underserved areas.**

10       **“SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-**  
11 **ation, there is appropriated to the Higher Education Coordinating**  
12 **Commission, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the Gen-**  
13 **eral Fund, the amount of \$1,500,000, to be distributed to the Oregon**  
14 **Health and Science University to coordinate the availability of behav-**  
15 **ioral health residential beds statewide.**

16       **“SECTION 3. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-**  
17 **ation, there is appropriated to the Department of Human Services, for**  
18 **the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the**  
19 **amount of \$4,000,000, which shall be expended for long term care fa-**  
20 **cility behavioral health specialty care.**

21       **“SECTION 4. This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate**  
22 **preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is**  
23 **declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect July 1, 2023.”.**
