PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2297

- Delete lines 4 through 8 of the printed bill and insert:
- "SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2023 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 238A.
- "SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section, 'uniformed services' has the meaning given that term in ORS 238.156.
- "(2) A person is entitled to receive retirement credit for up to three years of active service in the uniformed services, paid for on a pro rata basis by all participating public employers for whom the employee provided service, if:
- "(a) The person entered or reentered active service in the uniformed services after January 1, 1950, or was in active service in the uniformed services on January 1, 1950;
- 13 "(b) After being other than dishonorably discharged therefrom, the 14 person entered the employ of an employer participating in the Public 15 Employees Retirement System; and
- 16 "(c) The person's last qualifying position before retirement was as 17 a police officer or firefighter.
- 18 "(3) A person may not receive retirement credit under this section 19 for any period of service with the uniformed services for which the 20 person receives credit under the provisions of ORS 238A.150 or for 21 which the person is receiving or entitled to receive a pension or re-

- United States for the performance of service in the uniformed services. 2
- "(4) The Public Employees Retirement Board shall adopt rules regarding benefits, retirement credit and payments by participating em-4
- ployers for purposes of administering this section. 5

"SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2023 Act applies to members of the 6 Oregon Public Service Retirement Plan whose effective date of retire-7

ment is on or after the effective date of this 2023 Act.". 8
