- 13 "(a) A public elementary or secondary school for which attendance
- is compulsory under ORS 339.020;
- 15 "(b) A private or parochial elementary or secondary school, teach-
- ing children as described in ORS 339.030 (1)(a); or
- "(c) A child care facility as defined in ORS 329A.250 (5).
- "(2) Notwithstanding any other provision of ORS 197.660 to 197.670,
- 19 a local government may enact an ordinance:
- 20 "(a) Prohibiting a residential facility or residential home located
- 21 within a children's safety zone from employing or accepting as an

1 employee or resident:

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- "(A) A person required to report as a sex offender under ORS 163A.010, 163A.015, 163A.020 or 163A.025; or
- "(B) An individual convicted of a person felony, as that term is defined in the rules of the Oregon Criminal Justice Commission; or
- "(b) Requiring a residential facility or residential home located within a children's safety zone to provide adequate staff present on the premises at all times if a resident of the facility or home meets the criteria set forth in paragraph (a) of this subsection.".
