- "SECTION 1. (1) The State Department of Fish and Wildlife, in consultation with the Oregon Conservation and Recreation Advisory
- 6 Committee, shall award grants for the establishment or improvement
- 7 of public facilities for recreational fishing located inside an urban
- 8 growth boundary. Projects for which grants are awarded must serve
- 9 to protect, maintain or enhance fish and wildlife resources in Oregon,
- 10 **as described in ORS 496.252 (2).**

- "(2) Grants awarded under this section shall be paid out of the Oregon Conservation and Recreation Fund established under ORS 496.252.
 - "(3) In carrying out this section, the department shall consider opportunities to coordinate with the Restoration and Enhancement Board established under ORS 496.286 to enhance fishing access.
- "SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the State Department of Fish and Wildlife, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$200,000, for deposit in the Oregon Conservation and Recreation Fund established under ORS 496.252 for the purpose of

- awarding grants under section 1 of this 2023 Act.
- "SECTION 3. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 3 2026.

"SECTION 4. This 2023 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2023 regular session of the Eighty-second Legislative
