PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3488

- On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after "homeownership" delete the rest of the line and line 3 and insert "; and declaring an emergency.".
- Delete lines 5 through 26 and delete pages 2 through 5 and insert:
- 4 "SECTION 1. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
- 5 ation, there is appropriated to the Housing and Community Services
- 6 Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the Gen-
- 7 eral Fund:

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- 8 "(1) The amount of \$10,000,000, for deposit into the Housing and
- 9 Community Services Department Revolving Account to provide grants
- 10 to culturally responsive, culturally specific or tribal organizations to
- 11 provide down payment assistance.
 - "(2) The amount of \$25,000,000, for deposit into the Housing Finance
- 13 Fund to provide flexible loans to home purchasers.
- "SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
- 15 ation, there is appropriated to the Housing and Community Services
- Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the Gen-
- eral Fund, the amount of \$4,000,000, to provide grants to each of the
- 18 nine federally recognized tribes in Oregon, to be used to support low-
- 19 income individuals' homeownership needs, including through down
- 20 payment assistance, home purchasers' education and home repair
- 21 programs.

- "SECTION 3. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Housing and Community Services

 Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$4,800,000, to provide grants to up to 24 culturally responsive or culturally specific organizations to expand homeownership services.
 - "SECTION 4. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Bureau of Labor and Industries, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the General Fund:
 - "(1) The amount of \$2,400,000, to provide a grant to the Fair Housing Council of Oregon to support fair housing in this state.
 - "(2) The amount of \$2,300,000, to support the bureau's housing discrimination investigations and fair housing education and outreach.
 - "SECTION 5. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Department of Justice, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$500,000, to enforce fair housing laws.
 - "SECTION 6. This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect on July 1, 2023."

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
