PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3272

1 On <u>page 1</u> of the printed bill, line 2, after "state;" insert "creating new 2 provisions;".

3 In line 3, delete "and 56.185".

4 In line 16, delete "ORS" and insert "subsection (4) of this section".

5 In line 17, delete "56.185 (2)".

6 On page 2, after line 15, insert:

"(4)(a) The Secretary of State may collect information about the ethnicity,
gender, veteran status and street address or electronic mail address of each
owner and principal of a business that applies for or renews a business registration.

"(b) The Secretary of State may not make the information that the Secretary of State collects under paragraph (a) of this subsection available or searchable on the Internet unless the person to whom the information pertains has given explicit written consent to make the information available and searchable.

"(c) The Secretary of State may share or communicate with organizations described in subsection (2)(d) of this section, by electronic means or otherwise, the information that the Secretary of State collects under paragraph (a) of this subsection.".

In line 16, delete "(4)" and insert "(5)".

Delete lines 18 through 45 and delete <u>page 3</u> and insert:

"SECTION 2. (1) The amendments to ORS 56.180 by section 1 of this
 2023 Act become operative on January 1, 2027.

"(2) The Secretary of State may adopt rules and take any other action before the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section that is necessary to enable the Secretary of State, on and after the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section, to undertake and exercise all of the duties, functions and powers conferred on the Secretary of State by the amendments to ORS 56.180 by section 1 of this 2023 Act.

"SECTION 3. This 2023 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
 date on which the 2023 regular session of the Eighty-second Legislative
 Assembly adjourns sine die.".
