**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 2929**

1 In line 2 of the printed bill, delete “; amending ORS 537.781”.

2 Delete lines 4 through 13 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. If the Water Resources Department has information**  
4 **that a person has engaged in any activity that is in violation of ORS**  
5 **537.130, 537.535, 540.710 or 540.720, in addition to any other available**  
6 **remedies, the department may apply to the Circuit Court for Marion**  
7 **County, or to the circuit court for any county in which the activity**  
8 **has occurred, for a temporary or permanent injunction requiring the**  
9 **person to:**

10 **“(1) Refrain from the activity; and**

11 **“(2) Take any actions necessary to remedy the violation or any**  
12 **threat to water supplies, public health or public safety resulting from**  
13 **the violation.**

14 **“SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2,**  
15 **2030.**

16 **“SECTION 3. (1) On or before September 15, 2028, the Water Re-**  
17 **sources Department shall report, in the manner prescribed in ORS**  
18 **192.245, to a committee or interim committee of the Legislative As-**  
19 **sembly related to water on the department’s use of injunctive au-**  
20 **thority pursuant to section 1 of this 2023 Act.**

21 **“(2) The report must describe, but need not be limited to describing,**

1 the frequency of the department's pursuit of injunctions pursuant to  
2 section 1 of this 2023 Act and the outcomes of applying for, and being  
3 granted, injunctions pursuant to section 1 of this 2023 Act.

4 **SECTION 4. Section 3 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2,**  
5 **2030."**

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
