## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2345

In line 2 of the printed bill, after "custody" insert "; and prescribing an effective date".

3 Delete lines 4 through 9 and insert:

4 "<u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Department of Corrections shall undertake
5 reasonable efforts to reduce the number of days an adult in custody
6 may be in segregated housing at a department correctional facility.

"(2) The department shall establish a committee to study the implementation of subsection (1) of this section and develop recommendations outlining the staffing, program and facility needs required to
comply with section 2 of this 2023 Act.

11 "(3) The committee must consist of at least:

12 "(a) One individual who is currently an adult in custody.

13 "(b) One individual who was formerly an adult in custody.

"(c) One representative from each of the major unions representing
 department staff.

16 "(4) No later than September 1 of each year, the department shall 17 provide updated results of the study described in subsection (2) of this 18 section, along with any recommended legislative changes, in a report 19 to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to the 20 judiciary in the manner provided under ORS 192.245.

<sup>21</sup> "SECTION 2. An adult in custody may not be subject to segregated

housing at a department correctional facility for more than 14 consecutive days.

3 "SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2023 Act becomes operative on July
4 1, 2027.

5 "SECTION 4. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2,
6 2028.

"SECTION 5. This 2023 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
date on which the 2023 regular session of the Eighty-second Legislative
Assembly adjourns sine die.".

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
