- ² "SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Criminal Justice Commission shall
- 3 study the rates of recidivism and other outcomes of individuals who
- 4 received a pardon, reprieve or commutation from former Governor
- 5 Kate Brown, and compile a report that includes:
- 6 "(a) The name and complete criminal history of each individual who
- 7 received a pardon, reprieve or commutation from former Governor
- 8 Kate Brown.
- 9 "(b) Each crime of conviction and sentence subject to the pardon,
- 10 reprieve or commutation, and the effect the pardon, reprieve or com-
- mutation had on the victim of the crime, if any.
- 12 "(c) Whether an individual has been arrested, charged with a crime
- or convicted of a crime since receiving the pardon, reprieve or com-
- 14 mutation, including the specific crimes for each arrest, charge or
- 15 conviction.
- "(d) For all individuals arrested, charged with a crime or convicted
- of a crime since receiving a pardon, reprieve or commutation, a cat-
- 18 egorization of those crimes by offense level and by type of crime.
- 19 "(e) Whether any individual who was pardoned or had a sentence
- 20 commuted for a conviction related to controlled substances suffered a
- 21 fatal overdose after receiving the pardon or commutation.

"(2) The commission shall provide the report to the interim com-1 mittees of the Legislative Assembly related to the judiciary in the manner provided under ORS 192.245 no later than January 1, 2025. The commission may include in the report any other pertinent information the commission determines may inform the committees on future policy decisions concerning legislative limitations on the exercise of executive clemency.

"SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 8 **2025.**". 9
