## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 27

1	In line 2 of the printed bill, after "elections" insert "; and declaring an
2	emergency".
3	Delete lines 4 through 12 and insert:
4	"SECTION 1. (1) Pursuant to ORS 250.075 and notwithstanding ORS
5	250.035, if Joint Resolution (2023) (LC 4482) is referred to
6	the people by the Eighty-second Legislative Assembly in regular ses-
7	sion, the ballot title for Joint Resolution (2023) (LC 4482)
8	shall be:

10	AMENDS CONSTITUTION: "EQUALITY OF RIGHTS ON ACCOUNT
11	OF SEX" PROTECTS PREGNANCY AND GENDER IDENTITY AND
12	RELATED HEALTH DECISIONS, SEXUAL ORIENTATION; REPEALS
13	SAME-GENDER MARRIAGE BAN.
14	
15	RESULT OF "YES" VOTE: "YES" vote amends constitutional pro-
16	vision prohibiting government actions discriminating "on account of
17	sex" to include pregnancy and gender identity and related health de-
18	cisions and sexual orientation; repeals same-gender marriage ban.
19	
20	RESULT OF "NO" VOTE: "NO" vote retains current constitutional
21	provision prohibiting government actions impairing equal rights "on

1	account of sex" without expressly including pregnancy and gender
2	identity and related health decisions and sexual orientation.
3	
4	SUMMARY: In 2014, voters adopted Article I, section 46, of the Oregon
5	Constitution, which provides: "Equality of rights under the law shall
6	not be denied or abridged by the State of Oregon or by any political
7	subdivision in this state on account of sex." This measure identifies
8	protected rights "on account of sex" to include:
9	
10	• Pregnancy and pregnancy outcomes and related health decisions;
11	
12	<ul> <li>Gender identity and related health decisions;</li> </ul>
13	
14	• Sexual orientation; and
15	
16	• Gender.
17	
18	The measure repeals the current constitutional provision prohibit-
19	ing same-gender marriage. Additional major effects of this measure
20	include prohibiting state or local government actions:
21	
22	• Denying or abridging access to abortion, contraception, gender-
23	affirming health care and same-gender marriage; and
24	
25	• That discriminate, in intent or effect, based on pregnancy, gender
26	identity and related health decisions, miscarriage and other pregnancy
27	outcomes, sexual orientation and gender.

"(2) The word limits described in ORS 250.035 (2) do not apply to the

ballot title contained in this section.

"SECTION 2. A special election shall be held throughout this state 1 on the same date as the next general election. The measure that is 2 referred to in section 1 of this 2023 Act and that is otherwise referred to the people by the Legislative Assembly shall be submitted to the electors for their approval or rejection at the special election described in this section.

"SECTION 3. This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect on its passage.".
