- "(B) Plans administered by the Oregon Educators Benefit Board;
- "(C) Other state-administered health benefits;
- 16 "(D) Health benefit plans, as defined in ORS 743B.005; and
- 17 "(E) Other forms of insurance that provide pharmaceutical benefits, 18 to the extent permitted by federal law.
- "(2) No later than September 15, 2024, the board shall report to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to health, in the manner provided in ORS 192.245, the following information:

- "(a) A detailed explanation of the plan developed under subsection
- 2 (1) of this section.
- 3 "(b) An analysis of potential savings from or costs of implementing
- 4 the plan with respect to:
- 5 "(A) The state;
- 6 "(B) Insurers;
- 7 "(C) Hospitals; and
- 8 "(D) Consumers.".
