**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 5037**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 28 and delete page
2 2 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
4 the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July
5 1, 2023, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from fees,
6 moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but ex-
7 cluding lottery funds, federal funds and funds described in sections 2
8 to 5 of this 2023 Act, collected or received by the Department of State
9 Lands, for the following purposes:**

- 10 (1) Common School Fund
11 programs..... \$ 40,626,491
12 (2) South Slough National
13 Estuarine Research
14 Reserve operations..... \$ 3,076,736
15 (3) Capital improvements..... \$ 572,116

16 **“SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
17 the amount of \$2,121,125 is established for the biennium beginning July
18 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the De-
19 partment of State Lands from the Portland Harbor Cleanup Fund es-
20 tablished by ORS 274.064.**

21 **“SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,**

1 the amount of \$200,000 is established for the biennium beginning July
2 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the De-
3 partment of State Lands from the Submerged Lands Enhancement
4 Fund established by ORS 274.388.

5 **“SECTION 4.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
6 the amount of \$2,181,141 is established for the biennium beginning July
7 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the De-
8 partment of State Lands from the Oregon Removal-Fill Mitigation
9 Fund established by ORS 196.640.

10 **“SECTION 5.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
11 the amount of \$600,000 is established for the biennium beginning July
12 1, 2023, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses by the De-
13 partment of State Lands from the Oregon Ocean Science Fund estab-
14 lished by ORS 196.567.

15 **“SECTION 6.** Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures,
16 the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July
17 1, 2023, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from federal
18 funds collected or received by the Department of State Lands for the
19 following purposes:

- 20 (1) South Slough National
21 Estuarine Research
22 Reserve operations..... \$ 5,184,637
- 23 (2) Common School Fund
24 programs..... \$ 240,632

25 **“SECTION 7.** For the biennium beginning July 1, 2023, expenditures
26 by the Department of State Lands for tenant-incurred utility charges
27 and State Treasurer charges for investment-related transactions are
28 not limited.

29 **“SECTION 8.** This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate
30 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is

1 **declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect July 1, 2023.”.**
