RESULT OF "YES" VOTE: "YES" vote amends constitutional provision to provide constitutional right to a girl of any age to obtain an abortion through all nine months of pregnancy for any reason without parental knowledge, to gender identity support and sex reassignment surgery for minors over 15 without parental consent, and to sexual orientation; repeals provision on marriage being between one man and one woman.

RESULT OF "NO" VOTE: "NO" vote retains current constitutional
 provision prohibiting government actions impairing equal rights "on
 account of sex."

5 SUMMARY: In 2014, voters adopted Article I, section 46, of the Oregon 6 Constitution, which provides: "Equality of rights under the law shall 7 not be denied or abridged by the State of Oregon or by any political 8 subdivision in this state on account of sex." This measure creates new 9 protected rights including:

The measure repeals the current constitutional provision protecting marriage between one man and one woman. Additional major effects of this measure may include prohibiting state or local government actions limiting abortion or sex change and related procedures.
