**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 3333**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after the semicolon delete the rest
2 of the line and line 3 and insert “and declaring an emergency.”.

3 Delete lines 5 through 27 and delete pages 2 through 6 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. The System of Care Advisory Council shall study the**
5 **application of a just culture model in the investigative processes of**
6 **child-caring agencies. The council shall submit reports of its findings**
7 **in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, and may include recommen-**
8 **dations for legislation to implement any policy initiatives resulting**
9 **from the study, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly**
10 **related to human services. The first report is due no later than De-**
11 **cember 1, 2023, and the second report is due no later than September**
12 **15, 2024.**

13 **“SECTION 2. (1) As used in this section:**

14 **“(a) ‘Children in care’ means one or more child in care, as defined**
15 **in ORS 418.257.**

16 **“(b) ‘Just culture model’ means a culture where a person is not**
17 **punished for actions, omissions, suggestions or decisions taken by the**
18 **person that are commensurate with the person’s experience and**
19 **training, but where gross negligence, willful violations and destructive**
20 **acts are not tolerated.**

21 **“(2) The System of Care Advisory Council shall establish and ad-**

1 minister a grant program for the purpose of providing just culture
2 model training to Department of Human Services employees who
3 conduct investigations under ORS 418.257 to 418.259, staff working in
4 a child-caring agency, as defined in ORS 418.205, and behavioral health
5 care providers who work with children in care. Grants under this
6 section may be used for initial training as well as ongoing training and
7 supervision.

8 **“SECTION 3.** (1) As used in this section, ‘children in care’ means
9 one or more child in care, as defined in ORS 418.257.

10 **“(2)** The System of Care Advisory Council shall establish and ad-
11 minister a grant program for the purpose of providing grants for
12 training regarding trauma-informed practices and clinical best prac-
13 tices to the workforce providing residential services to children in
14 care.

15 **“SECTION 4.** (1) The System of Care Advisory Council Training
16 Fund is established in the State Treasury separate and distinct from
17 the General Fund. The fund shall consist of all moneys placed in the
18 fund as provided by law.

19 **“(2)** Moneys in the fund are continuously appropriated to the
20 Oregon Health Authority to:

21 **“(a)** Provide moneys for the grant programs described in sections 2
22 and 3 of this 2023 Act; and

23 **“(b)** Pay the costs of administering the grant programs described
24 in sections 2 and 3 of this 2023 Act.

25 **“(3)** The authority may accept gifts, grants or contributions from
26 any public or private source for deposit into the fund.

27 **“SECTION 5.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
28 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the
29 biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount
30 of \$____, for deposit in the System of Care Advisory Council Training

1 Fund established under section 4 of this 2023 Act, for the purpose of
2 carrying out the provisions of section 2 of this 2023 Act.

3 **“SECTION 6.** In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
4 ation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Health Authority, for the
5 biennium beginning July 1, 2023, out of the General Fund, the amount
6 of \$____, for deposit in the System of Care Advisory Council Training
7 Fund established under section 4 of this 2023 Act, for the purpose of
8 carrying out the provisions of section 3 of this 2023 Act.

9 **“SECTION 7.** Section 1 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2,
10 2025.

11 **“SECTION 8.** This 2023 Act being necessary for the immediate
12 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is
13 declared to exist, and this 2023 Act takes effect on its passage.”.

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
