PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 889

- On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after "ORS" insert "801.190,".
- 2 Delete lines 4 through 31.
- 3 Delete page 2 and insert:
- 4 **"SECTION 1.** ORS 801.194 is amended to read:
- 5 "801.194. (1) 'Class III all-terrain vehicle' means a motorcycle that travels
- on two tires and that is actually being operated off highway.
- 7 "(2) 'Class IV all-terrain vehicle' means any motorized vehicle that:
- 8 "(a) Travels on four or more tires designed for off-road use only
- 9 [pneumatic tires that are six inches or more in width and that are designed
- 10 for use on wheels with a rim diameter of 14 inches or less];
- "(b) Is designed for or capable of cross-country travel on or immediately
- over land, water, sand, snow, ice, marsh, swampland or other natural terrain;
- "(c) Has nonstraddle seating;
- "(d) Has a steering wheel for steering control;
- "(e) Has a dry weight of [2,500] **3,500** pounds or less; [and]
- "(f) Is [80] **75** inches wide or less at its widest point; and
- "(g) Was originally manufactured for off-road use only.
- "SECTION 2. ORS 801.190 is amended to read:
- 19 "801.190. 'Class I all-terrain vehicle' means a motorized, off-highway rec-
- 20 reational vehicle that:
- "(1) Is 50 inches or less in width;

- "(2) Has a dry weight of 1,200 pounds or less;
- 2 "(3) Travels on three or more tires designed for off-road use only
- 3 [pneumatic tires that are six inches or more in width and that are designed
- 4 for use on wheels with a rim diameter of 14 inches or less];
- 5 "(4) Uses handlebars for steering;
- 6 "(5) Has a seat designed to be straddled for the operator; and
- 7 "(6) Is designed for or capable of cross-country travel on or immediately
- 8 over land, water, sand, snow, ice, marsh, swampland or other natural terrain.
- 9 **"SECTION 3.** ORS 821.040 is amended to read:
- "821.040. (1) A person commits the offense of operation of an off-road ve-
- 11 hicle without required equipment if the person is operating a vehicle de-
- scribed in ORS 821.010 in an area described in ORS 821.020 and the vehicle
- is not equipped in compliance with all of the following:
- "(a) The vehicle must be equipped with a muffler that meets the standards
- 15 for noise emissions established under ORS 821.030.
- 16 "(b) The vehicle must be equipped with brakes that meet the requirements
- 17 established under ORS 821.030.
- "[(c) The vehicle must be equipped with a windshield wiper if the vehicle
- 19 is equipped with a windshield.]
 - "(c) When the vehicle is operated on a highway and the vehicle is
 - equipped with a windshield, the top edge of which is at least six inches
- 22 above the steering wheel, the vehicle must be equipped with a
- 23 windshield wiper.
 - "(d) When the vehicle is operated off the highway and the vehicle
- 25 is equipped with a windshield, the windshield must be unobstructed.
- "[(d)] (e) When the vehicle is operated on sand, the vehicle must be
- 27 equipped with a flag that meets the requirements established under ORS
- 28 821.030.

- "[(e)] (f) The vehicle must be equipped with any safety equipment required
- 30 under ORS 821.030.

- "[(f)] (g) At any time from one-half hour after sunset to one-half hour after sunrise, the vehicle must be equipped with and display headlights and taillights.
- "(2) Motorcycles and mopeds are not required by this section to be equipped with windshield wipers.
- 6 "(3) The offense described in this section, operation of off-road vehicle 7 without required equipment, is a Class C traffic violation.

"SECTION 4. The amendments to ORS 821.040 by section 3 of this
9 2023 Act apply to offenses committed on or after the effective date of
10 this 2023 Act.".
