PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2099

- In line 2 of the printed bill, after "transportation" insert "; creating new provisions; and amending ORS 366.506".
- 3 Delete lines 4 through 11 and insert:
- 4 **"SECTION 1.** ORS 366.506 is amended to read:
- 5 "366.506. (1) Once every two years, the Oregon Department of Adminis-
- 6 trative Services shall conduct [either a full] a highway cost allocation study
- 7 [or an examination of data collected since the previous study]. The [purposes]
- 8 **purpose** of the study [or examination of data are] is to determine:
- 9 "(a) The proportionate share that the users of each class of vehicle should
 - pay for the costs of maintenance, operation and improvement of the high-
- ways, roads and streets in the state; and
- "(b) Whether the users of each class are paying that share.
 - "(2) Each study must include:

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- "(a) An examination of the most recent study period for which actual data are available for the purpose of determining the accuracy of the most recently published study results; and
- "(b) An examination of the prospective study period based on projected data for the purpose described in subsection (1) of this section.
 - "[(2)] (3) The department may use any study design [it] the department

- determines will best accomplish the purposes stated in subsection (1) of this
- 2 section. In designing the study, the department may make decisions that in-
- 3 clude, but are not limited to, the methodology to be used for the study, what
- 4 constitutes a class of vehicle for purposes of collection of data under sub-
- sections (1) to [(4)] (5) of this section and the nature and scope of costs that
- 6 will be included in the study.
- 7 "[(3)] (4) The department may appoint a study review team to participate
- 8 in the study [or examination of data] required by subsection (1) of this sec-
- 9 tion. The team may perform any functions assigned by the department, in-
- 10 cluding, but not limited to, consulting on the design of the study.
- "[(4)] (5) A report on the results of the study [or examination of data]
- shall be submitted to the legislative revenue committees and the [legislative
- committees with primary responsibility for transportation] Joint Committee
- on Transportation by January 31 of each odd-numbered year.
- "[(5)] (6) The Legislative Assembly shall use the report described in
- 16 [subsections (1) to (4)] subsection (5) of this section to determine whether
- adjustments to revenue sources described in Article IX, section 3a (3), [Ar-
- 18 ticle IX] of the Oregon Constitution, are needed in order to carry out the
- 19 purposes of Article IX, section 3a (3), [Article IX] of the Oregon Constitu-
- 20 tion. If such adjustments are needed, the Legislative Assembly shall enact
- 21 whatever measures are necessary to make the adjustments.
 - "SECTION 2. (1) The Oregon Department of Administrative Services
 - shall prepare and submit a report that includes an analysis of, at least,
- 24 the three most recent reported highway cost allocation studies con-
- 25 ducted under ORS 366.506.

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- "(2) For each of the three previous study periods, the analysis must:
- 27 "(a) Evaluate the amount that users of each class of vehicle actu-
- 28 ally paid for the cost of maintenance, operation and improvement of
- 29 highways, roads and streets in the state; and
 - "(b) Whether the amount paid was a proportionate share of those

1 costs.

"(3) The department shall submit the report, in the manner provided by ORS 192.245, to the Joint Committee on Transportation no later than September 15, 2024.

5 "SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2023 Act is repealed on January 2, 6 2025.".

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
