- On page 2, after line 1, insert:
- 4 "(5) A county must initiate a proceeding under section 5 (1) of this 2023
- 5 Act if a petition is filed by a party to a proceeding to revoke the approval
- 6 described in subsection (1)(c) of this section in which the county determines
- 7 whether any property subject to that revocation proceeding, that is not
- 8 owned by an innocent purchaser, was determined to be a lawfully established
- 9 unit of land based on false records."

- "SECTION 4. Section 5 of this 2023 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 197.
  - "SECTION 5. (1) Notwithstanding the finality of a land use decision, principles of issue or claim preclusion or requirements in ORS 197.830 for the review of a land use decision, a local government may review and revoke a determination made within a previous land use decision that the property was a lawfully established unit of land, as defined in ORS 92.010, if the determination was based on false records.
- "(2) If, as part of a land use proceeding that requires a local government to determine whether a property is a lawfully established unit of land, the local government determines that its prior determination

- that a property was a lawfully established unit of land was based on
- 2 false records, the local government cannot rely on the prior determi-
- a nation and must revoke the determination under subsection (1) of this
- 4 section.
- 5 "(3) A local government's revocation under this section is a land 6 use decision.
- "(4) As used in this section, 'false records' means deeds or records
  that are fabricated, fraudulent or inaccurate.
- "SECTION 6. Section 5 of this 2023 Act applies to determinations made within land use decisions arising before, on or after the effective date of this 2023 Act.".
